AMENDMENT NUMBER 525, 2011**

TAKE NOTICE that the ST. JOHN'S Development Regulations Amendment Number 525, 2011 adopted on the 7th day of November, 2011, has been registered by the Minister of Municipal Affairs.

In general terms, the purpose of Development Regulations Amendment Number 525, 2011 is to rezone land located between Blackmarsh Road and Captain Whelan Drive from the Residential Low Density (R1) Zone to the Apartment Medium Density (A2) Zone.

This Amendment comes into effect on the day that this notice is published in *The Newfoundland and Labrador Gazette*. Anyone who wishes to inspect a copy of it may do so at the Department of Planning, St. John's City Hall during regular business hours.
